Mitsubishi Electric launches MELControl

Mitsubishi Electric is launching its new MELControl system that allows you to control your heat pump or air conditioning using Wi-Fi. It can be used at home and in your summer cottage; even where there is no internet connection!

Do you want to control your heat pump or air conditioning remotely via Wi-Fi in your summer cottage? Is there no internet connection there? Using Mitsubishi Electric's MELControl system this is no longer a problem. The MELControl system contains a wireless router (D-Link) and MELCloud. With this wireless router and a SIM card you get an internet connection to your house and can control your heat pump using MELCloud. All you need is a SIM card.



MELControl works together with MELCloud, a Wi-Fi app, allowing you to easily control your heat pump or air conditioning whether you are on the move or relaxing on the sofa. The MELCloud app gives the user effortless control of their heating as well as access to important information about the heat pump's operation, such as temperature and malfunctions. Accessing and controlling Mitsubishi Electric products has never been simpler and is now possible via your PC, tablet and/or smartphone.
